More Bites

Recipe of the Month

Sweet Potato Casserole
from Linda Simpson

Ingredients

- 1 large can of sweet potatoes
- 1 cup brown sugar
- 1 egg
- 1/2 stick melted butter
- 1/2 tsp cinnamon
- 1/2 tsp nutmeg
- 1 1/2 cup milk

Drain potatoes - add sugar, egg, spices, butter, and milk to potatoes. Beat until fairly smooth. Pour into a buttered 9" X 13" dish.

Topping

- 3/4 cup white sugar
- 3/4 cup chopped pecans
- 1/2 tsp cinnamon
- 1 stick butter (sliced)
- 1/2 cup flour


Place 1 stick of butter, sliced on top of topping, and bake for 1 hour at 350 degrees.

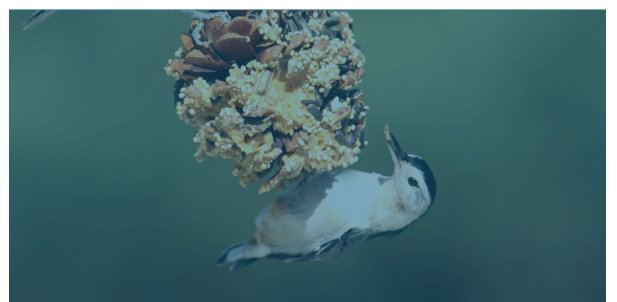
